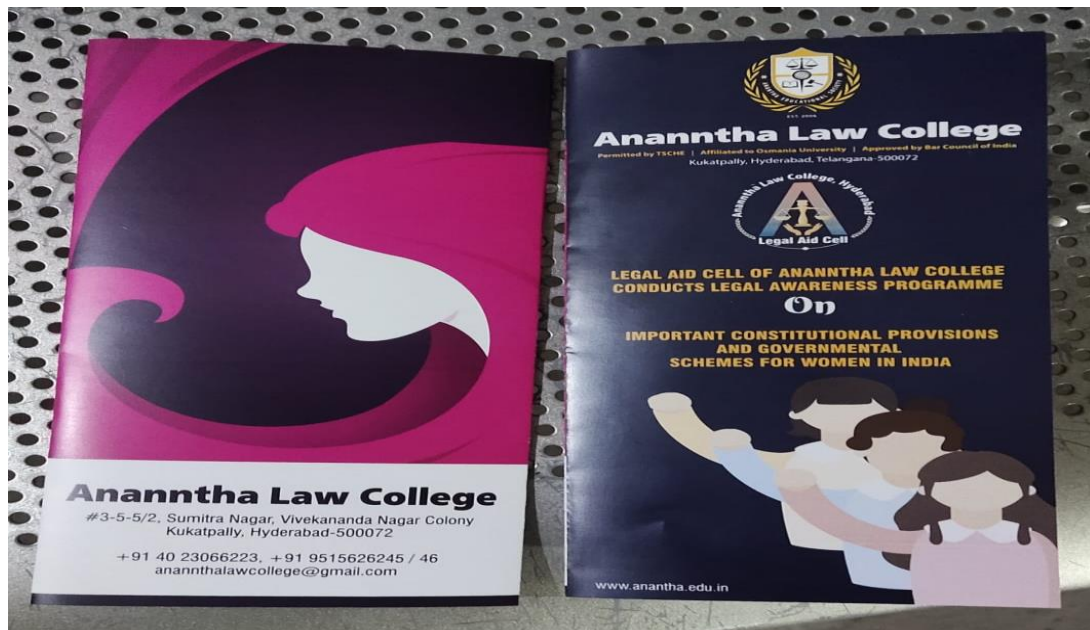




Report On “Legal Awareness Programme on Important Constitutional and Legal Provisions For Women in India. Conducted on 10th November, 2021 at Pragathi Degree College for Women

Objective: The main objective of this legal aid camp is to create awareness among young girls. Women are usually oppressed as they are not aware of their Rights as a result they often suffer in silence without knowing a way out. Neither the Schools nor the societal norms teach about woman's Rights, as she is always taught to compromise or adjust. Therefore, it is necessary to educate Young Girls about their Legal Rights to lead their life peacefully and to achieve their Goals.
